Please find the information advising you of **The Girls Champions Cup Primary Schools Football Championships, for 2020**. This is the **14th year** of these Championships. The previous 13 years have been very successful with the Championships going from strength to strength.

The Champions Cup was changed in 2019 to align it with the Football Federation of Australia requirements and with School Sports Australia changing the National Championships to a 9-a-side competition.

WA has a State Under 12 Girls State Team. Unfortunately, due to the Covid-19 Pandemic the 2020 National Championships have been cancelled. Hopefully they will recommence in 2021, If your daughter is interested in trialling please go to www.schoolsportwa.com.au and complete the nomination form. The State Team will be participating in the National Championships in Darwin next year. The girls will be playing against the other States and Territories.

We hope to have your support in making it a successful Championship again, to be looked forward to each year, so that your daughter and all girls participating can have a great time playing the World Game, in a fun and professionally organised competition, under the auspices of School Sport WA.

The Eastern and Southern Regions will be played on Friday, 31st July 2020.

The State Championship Finals will be played on Friday, 14th August 2020.

- They are all purpose built facilities that serve as football venues.
- They have change rooms and ablution facilities.

TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENTS:

- It is a school's responsibility to transport the students to and from the Regional Championship venues.
- It is the parent's responsibility to transport the students to and from the State Championship Semi-Finals and Grand Final.

STUDENT CONTACT ARRANGEMENTS DURING CHAMPIONSHIPS:

- School teacher/s will be in attendance at all times. School teacher's contact number during Championships is _____ **(School to provide mobile number).**

SUPERVISORY TEAM:

- The students will be supervised by their school teacher/s, for the Regional Championships and are attending due to their expertise and interest in the area of Football. (Student/Teacher ratio: 14/1) **See above dates.**
- Parents and teacher/s will supervise students during the Qualifying Finals and State Grand Final on Friday 14th August, 2020.
- Qualified First Aid personnel will be at each Regional Championship. **See above dates.**
- Qualified First Aid personnel will be at the State Championship Qualifying Finals and Grand Final on Friday 14th August, 2020.

STAFF ACTION IN CASE OF ACCIDENT OR ILLNESS AT THE CHAMPIONSHIPS:

- Qualified First Aid personnel will be in attendance to render emergency care.
- Parents will be contacted immediately.
- **The teacher-in-charge has a list of the names of participating students, contact telephone numbers and student medical information. The teacher will have a mobile phone to ensure effective communication for parents or the school.**

SUPERVISION STRATEGIES:

All participants

- will be under the immediate supervision of their school teacher/s.
- will be required to remain on site for the duration of the Championships unless accompanied by their parent/guardian.
- The school teacher/s must be advised prior to any parents removing their children from the venue.

SPECIAL CLOTHING OR OTHER ITEMS REQUIRED:

- The school will provide the playing shirts and bibs, just in case of a colour clash. Away team to change.
- **Students must have shin pads. Referees will not allow players to participate if they are not wearing them.**
- It is advisable that children wear football boots.

NOTE:

Staff supervising students at the Championships will take all reasonable care while the students are in their charge to protect them from injury and to control and supervise their behaviour and activities. Parents/guardians should be aware that staff members are not responsible for injuries or damage to property, which may occur during these Championships where, in all circumstances, staff have not been negligent.

Parents are required to present to the organisers, well before the Championships, any change to their child's health and fitness.

Where it is considered necessary, School Teachers and First Aid staff will arrange medical assessment and treatment for students. Parents will be contacted immediately, where it is deemed necessary.
