EVENT: The Girls Champions Cup Primary Schools Regional and State Football Championships 2020

TIME: Commences approx. 9:30am and concludes approx. 2:30pm

DATES and REGIONS:

Regional Championships:

School Sports WA shall conduct the Championships each year for students in Years 4, 5 and 6 girls only.

The Northern Regional Championships will be held on Thursday, 30th July 2020

The Southern and Eastern Regional Championships will be held on Friday 31st July 2020.

The State Championship Finals, (Qualifying Finals, Semi Finals and State Grand Final) between the Champions and Runners-Up of the four Regions will be held on Friday, 14th August 2020.

School Sport WA proudly provides the following information to Principals to assist in the completing of checklist **(App A)** of the Department's excursions and management plan.

THE ENVIRONMENT/LOCATION:

- The venues are:

Southern Regional Championship	Beale Park, Hamilton Road, Spearwood
Eastern Regional Championship	Hossack Reserve, Hossack Avenue, Parkwood
Northern Regional Championships	Kingsway Reserve, Landsdale
State Championship Qualifying Finals and Grand Final	Aubin Grove Community Oval, Camden Boulevard, Aubin Grove
- They are purpose built facilities that serve as football venues.
- They have change rooms and ablution facilities.

TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENTS:

- It is a school's responsibility to transport the students to and from the Regional Championship venues.
- It is the parent's responsibility to transport the students to and from the State Championship Semis and Grand Final.

THE STUDENTS' CAPACITY:

Students are nominated by their schools on the basis of their sporting ability. Information related to the students' health has been requested in writing from the students' parents.

THE SUPERVISORY TEAM:

- The students will be supervised by their school teacher/s, for the Regional Championships and are attending due to their expertise and interest in the area of Football. (Student/Teacher ratio: 14/1) [See above dates.](#)
- Parents and teacher/s will supervise students during the Semi-Finals and State Grand Final on Friday, 14th August, 2020.
- Qualified First Aid personnel will be at each Regional Championship. [See above dates.](#)
- Qualified First Aid personnel will be at the State Championship Qualifying-Finals and Grand Final on Friday, 14th August 2020.

THE INVOLVEMENT OF EXTERNAL PROVIDERS:

- Health care at the Championships will be provided by Professionally Qualified First Aid personnel.
- School Sports Australia has liability insurance to a limit of \$15million.

SUPERVISION STRATEGIES:

All participants:

- will be under the immediate supervision of their school teacher/s.
- will be required to remain on site for the duration of the Championships unless accompanied by their parent/guardian. The school teacher/s must be advised prior to any parents removing their children from the venue.

IDENTIFYING PARTICIPANTS:

- Students will wear their school's football shirts or school uniform for quick and easy identification.

PROVIDE INFORMATION AND SEEK CONSENT:

- Parents/guardians of student participants have been provided with full details of the Championships.
- Parent information sheets are available on the SSWA web site (www.schoolsportwa.com.au). They are provided here for your assistance.

COMMUNICATION STRATEGIES:

- A clearly designated central meeting place will be used to communicate with participants.
- All teachers are to have whistles to attract attention of their groups.

EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLANNING:

- A designated assembly point will be shown to all participants prior to the Championship's commencement.
- Participants will move to this point under the direction of their supervising teacher/s.
- 3 short blasts of the air horn will notify students, teachers and spectators in case of an emergency.
- **The teacher-in-charge has a list of the names of participating students, contact telephone numbers and student medical information. The teacher will have a mobile phone to ensure effective communication for parents or the school.**

SPECIAL CLOTHING OR OTHER ITEMS REQUIRED:

- The school will provide the playing shirts, shorts etc. Bibs will be supplied, just in case of a colour clash. Away team to change.
- **Students must have shin pads. If they don't, they can't play. This is a crucial duty of care issue. Schools to provide shin pads if students do not have their own.**
- It is advisable that children wear football boots.

BRIEF STUDENTS AND SUPERVISORS:

- All relevant information will be provided to all participants prior to the Championship's commencement.
