



# 2021 CHAMPION SCHOOLS HANDBALL

(Recommended for Years 5 & 6 students)



**VENUE: North Woodvale P.S.** (4 Chichester Drive, WOODVALE)

**WHEN: Term 4 Week 6 – Friday, 19<sup>th</sup> November**

Champion Schools Handball is a one-day primary school tournament. The host school (North Woodvale Primary) will supply required handball equipment and goals. Weather shelters will be set up alongside courts and plenty of tree-shade can be found around the outside of the School's oval. If schools have their own shade shelters it may be a good idea to bring along to make sure that your students have somewhere to base themselves when not playing. Toilets and water taps are near the oval gates. Visiting teachers are responsible for the supervision of their students at all times and teams must have a coach/manager.

**Schools:** **Hocking Boys (A & B) and Hocking Girls (A & B)**  
**Woodvale Boys (A & B) and Woodvale Girls (A & B)**  
**North Woodvale Boys (A & 2 x B) and North Woodvale Girls (A & 2 x B)**  
**Scotch College Boys (A & B)**  
**Landsdale Boys (A & 2 x B) and Landsdale Girls (A & B)**

**Teams:** Schools may enter one team of 7 players + reserves in each division (*Boys A, Boys B, Girls A & Girls B*). Must be represented in all divisions to be eligible for the Overall Champion School Perpetual Shield. Since Scotch is a college for boys, North Woodvale has entered an extra *Girls and Boys B* team to help make up numbers. Landsdale were given permission to enter a second B division boys team. Only one of the North Woodvale and Landsdale *B* teams (with most points) goes toward perpetual shields.

**Cost:** \$30 per team

**Courts:** All handball courts (grass) are located on the School's oval.

**Games:** Each game consists of 2 x 10 minute halves with a 3 minute changeover at half-time. There is a 7 minute break between games except for recess (20 min) and lunch (25 min). An air horn will sound to indicate the start and finish of each half. Please have teams ready to play on time.

**Subs:** Teams may substitute players during breaks in play (referee to be notified) and again at half-time. Any number of players may be substituted. In the case of an injury, the game will be stopped and the injured player replaced as quickly as possible. Note: 'B' players may play for 'A' teams, but 'A' players are not permitted to play for 'B' teams.

**Referees:** Where possible, umpires will be provided. Schools are asked to provide a referee that may be called upon during the day and they should have a good understanding of the most current version of modified rules. The referee's decision is final. All players are expected to display a positive sports attitude.

**Scoring:** Each goal scored is to be recorded on the game scoresheet and scoreboard by North Woodvale student helpers under the supervision of the referee at each court. At full-time, both the referee and helpers should confirm the final score then deliver the completed game scoresheet to the chief scorer located next to court 1.

**Points:** 2 points for a win    1 point to each team for a draw    0 points for a loss

For *Girls A*, there will be a final round where 1<sup>st</sup> vs 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> vs 4<sup>th</sup>. In **all other divisions** the team with most points at the completion of all fixtures will be declared 'Champions'. The team with the second most points will be declared 'Runner-up Champions'. In the event of a tie on points, a 'Head to Head' result will be used to break the deadlock. A trophy will be awarded to 'Champions' and 'Runner-up Champions' in all four divisions. Perpetual shields will be presented to the 'Overall Champion Boys' & 'Overall Champion Girls' with most points from their two gender divisions combined, and, to the 'Overall Champion School' with most points from the four divisions combined. In the event of a tie, the school group which scored most goals on the day will be placed higher.

**First Aid:** First aid and sun protection is the responsibility of all schools. Host school to supply ice packs.

**Canteen:** For the convenience of staff, competing students and their parents there will be a Coffee Van and hopefully a Boost Juice van in attendance.
