

WA TEACHERS' GAMES ELIGIBILITY POLICY

RATIONALE

The aim of this policy is to define the eligibility criteria for registration and participation at the WA Teachers' Games (WATG).

Eligibility is subject to participants' agreement of related WATG policies, which is part of the registration process. Individuals, or teams with individuals, identified as being ineligible for whatever reason, will be disqualified and removed from the event.

WATG PARTICIPANT CRITERIA

To be eligible to attend the WA Teachers' Games, participants must fall under one or more of the following categories:-

1. A current teacher within any Western Australian school (government or non-government)
2. All staff employed by a Western Australian school – including classroom and non-classroom support staff. This excludes pre-service teachers.
3. A current holder of a valid WA Teachers' Registration (including current casual relief teachers throughout Western Australia)
4. A current employee of the Department of Education (DoE). Corporate staff (including from non-government education institutions) are included.
5. A retired teacher of the workforce
6. Registered volunteers and official sponsor staff

Acknowledgement of the above category will be required when registering for WATG.
