The longevity of Country Week says something powerful about the spirit of the involved schools and the importance of this event in the lives of students, families, and communities across regional Western Australia.

Each year our event and community continue to grow, with 2025 no exception. It was a week of highlights with a record breaking 56 schools attending and 4000 students participating across 1300 fixtured events... all in just 5 days!

Throughout the week there was an excellent display of athleticism, creativity, teamwork, and determination. Country Week is not just about sport – it's a celebration of student excellence in all forms.

A special mention goes out to the WA Government for providing the **Country Week Assistance Program!** 

This Program aims to alleviate the expenses of attending Country Week and reduces the cost per student by \$250 if they attend a school within 300km of Perth or \$500 per student if the school is more than 300kms.
