Times

- Teams **should arrive by no later than 8.45am**
- Briefing will commence @ 8.50am
- Games will **commence at 9.00am sharp**
- Presentations will be made at approx. 2.35pm

Umpires

- Each team must supply **one competent** umpire per team for each game. An adult or badged umpire is required for all Open Division games. SSWA will aim to provide referees for all Open Division games.
- SSWA will aim to source umpires to assist with Championship divisions. More information will be sent out early Term 2.

Other information

- Each team/school should have own first aid kit.
- Kiosk facilities – drinks, snacks, toasted sandwiches etc

RULES

- 12 players allowed per team (**all team players full names need to be recorded on score-card of first game played only**)
- **Rolling subs will be used for the carnival in all grades.**
- **Players are not interchangeable between teams**
- **Players must be a minimum of year 7 enrolled at your school**
- Should any concerns or issues arise by opposing teams or umpires during a game, please seek the Coordinator and/or representative **during the game**.
- Players must wear school uniform. Short nails, NO jewellery/adornments (exceptions: medical) and suitable footwear is recommended.
- All games should consist of **two 12 minute halves with a 1 minute** break at half time.
- Time keeping of all games will be centrally controlled
- First named team will have a representative as the "Scorer" and will be responsible to return scorecard to the office **immediately after game**. Second named team should have a representative next to scorer to verify at all times during the game.
- No injury time will be allowed, umpires please use discretion
- Rules governing match play are as set out in the WA Netball Rule Book, unless otherwise stated.
- **Should a team not be on court & ready to commence play at designated time slot, the opposing team will be awarded 1 goal for each minute passed until the end of the first half.** (This must be verified by the umpire, advised to both teams and must be noted on the score card). There after the late team will have forfeited the game. The opposing team that has now been deemed the winning team will have 10 goals on the scorecard and 2 points on the ladder.
- If the organiser has to stop play for inclement weather the following will apply:
 - a) If the game has not commenced:
 - i. The game is to be rescheduled.
 - ii. If it cannot be rescheduled, then the game is considered a draw. Both teams accumulate 10 goals and 1 point each on the ladder count.
 - b) If the game has already commenced:
 - i. If the game has not gone past the half time, then the game is considered a draw. Both teams accumulate 10 goals and 1 point each on the ladder count. .
 - ii. If the game has gone past the half time. The scorecard stands as the final result of the game as at the time of the stoppage.

- **Ladders & Finals**

- Each team will be awarded
 - 2 points per win
 - 1 point for a draw
 - 0 points per loss

At the end of the rounds, the teams will be ranked 1 through to end in pools/divisions. Should there be a tie in points, we will calculate winners by highest percentage (win/loss goals). **Pool Round Placing will be displayed on pin up board outside office area. Please check.** This will determine

A) Premiers of Division **OR**

B) Cross Over Finals to be played for final placing.

- NOTE: If at the end of full time during any Finals (Cross Over and/or Grand Final) if scores are even - teams will continue to play until one team is two (2) goals in the lead. This team will then be deemed the winning team.
(No substitution of players will be allowed after full time. All players must continue play with existing positions as at full time. Injury rules still apply.)

Only Teams in Champion Divisions are eligible for Schools Sports Elimination Day invitation and this is determined by eventual Premiers and Runners Up.
