

Information	Secondary Volleyball Information & Rules Champion of Champions Cup
Net Heights	• Senior Boys – 2.35m Senior Girls – 2.15m • Junior Boys – 2.24m Junior Girls – 2.15m
Game Length	• 40 minutes • 10 minutes between games
Game Scoring	• 3 compulsory sets unless time runs out • First 2 sets to 21 points with rally point scoring (capped) • 3rd set to 15 points with rally point scoring (capped) • No 2 point advantage • If time expires and both teams are one set all with no play yet in the 3rd set, a golden point will be played to decide the set. The next server in the rotation will take the serve. Do not change ends. • If during 3rd set time expires and both teams are one set all and even on points a golden point will decide the set. • If during 3rd set time expires and both teams are one set all and one team is leading that team shall win the game 2 sets to 1
Game Results	• Win – 4 points; Forfeit – 4 points; Loss – 0 points • Teams scoring a forfeit win will be awarded a 3-0 score line and will be awarded points 21 / 0 for the first 2 sets and 15 / 0 for the 3rd set. • After round matches where 2 or more teams are equal on points the winner will be decided on sets won • If 2 teams are still drawn then points for will decide the winner • If 2 teams are still drawn then the result of their previous encounter will decide the winner
Playing Numbers	• Single gender teams only • Teams may play up to a maximum of 12 players with 6 players at any one time • Whilst it is preferable to have 6 players on court games may go ahead with 5 players provided that the service rotation is adhered to. • If a team has 4 or less players that team will record a forfeit loss result
Warm Up	• Ideally a minimum of 5 minutes up to 15 minutes • Teams may warm up as soon as a preceding game finishes but not start until the central timing buzzer is sounded.
Referees / Duty Teams	• Where possible all games to be covered with SSWA organised referees • Schools rostered to supply student officials (2 x scorers; 2 x line officials) • A school staff member may be required to step in to fill a referee position if no referee appears on court

Sanctions	• Referees that deem behaviour to be unsatisfactory shall send off a player for 5 minutes (Yellow Card) • Unsatisfactory behaviour may include swearing, disputing referee decisions and any uncooperative or disruptive behaviours • This player may be replaced immediately • If a player receives a second yellow card it immediately turns into a red card and the player is sent off for the remainder of the game and may not be replaced • A direct red card leads to the players being sent off for the remainder of the game and may not be replaced • The Event Coordinator must be made aware of the report who then makes the Manager School Sport aware who in turn makes the Principal of the offending players school aware of the report
Equipment	• Match ball is supplied by the first named school
Substitutions	• Coaches choose either orthodox or unorthodox substitution • Coaches cannot use a combination of both
Time Outs	• One per team per set • No time-outs in last 3 minutes of timed play
Mercy Rule	• No rule
